christians who are confused by the homosexuality debate raging in the us are looking for

resources that are based solidly on a deep study of what scripture says about the issue in people to be loved preston sprinkle challenges those on all sides of the debate to consider what the bible says and how we should approach the topic of homosexuality in light of it in a manner that appeals to a scholarly and lay audience alike preston takes on difficult questions such as how should the church treat people struggling with same sex attraction is same sex attraction a product of biological or societal factors or both how should the church think about larger cultural issues such as gay marriage gay pride and whether intolerance over lgbt amounts to racism how or if christians should do business with lgbt persons and supportive companies simply saying that the bible condemns homosexuality is not accurate nor is it enough to end the debate those holding a traditional view still struggle to reconcile the bible s prohibition of same sex attraction with the message of radical unconditional grace this book meets that need

s matthew liao argues here that children have a right to be loved to do so he investigates questions such as whether children are rightholders what grounds a child s right to beloved whether love is an appropriate object of a right and other philosophical and practical issues his proposal is that all human beings have rights to the fundamental conditions for pursuing a good life therefore as human beings children have human rights to the fundamental conditions for pursuing a good life since being loved is one of those fundamental conditions children thus have a right to be loved liao shows that this claim need not be merely empty rhetoric and that the arguments for this right can hang together as a coherent whole this is the first book to make a sustained philosophical case for the right of children to be loved it makes a unique contribution to the fast growing literature on family ethics in particular on children s rights and parental rights and responsibilities and to the emerging field of the philosophy of human rights
