this 1840 book of mormon was carefully revised by joseph smith jr and is the last edition he worked on it is the third edition and was published in nauvoo illinois it was published without an index or preface but does contain the testimony of the three and eight witnesses

in the nineteenth century it was a common belief that native americans were the descendants of the ten lost tribes of israel ethan smith wrote on this topic and in so doing challenged the dismissal of the indigenous americans by european settlers smith used biblical scripture similarities in the hebrew and native american languages and their name for god and other points of evidence to prove the connection between israel and the first nations from there he showed how the reunited hebrew tribes would be restored to zion before the end of the world perhaps the most fascinating aspect of smith s book is that it is said to have influenced the book of mormon which was published about seven years after later as a child smith moved away from religion after his parents died but found his way back before he turned 20 and worked in the ministry until his death smith wrote several books while serving in the ministry in which he explored prophecies and baptism among other subjects but this book remains one of the most controversial of all his publications

this volume deals with the subject of learning by heart in the context of protestant teaching what traditions are there what potential does this religious cultural technique hold memorizing is identified here not just against the background of the observations of jan und aleida assmann on cultural memory as the chief mode of the judaeo christian culture of remembrance it is shown how important mnemonics was in this field from the reformation to the mid 20th century only in the course of the decade of reforms did it begin to lose significance the author uses basic insights on cultural memory and specifies the potential of learning off by heart for processes in religious education the formation of social identity the constitution of personal identity counterfactual suspension religious performance and the competence to use theological reasoning thus even at the horizon of modernity memorizing the original mode of judaeo christian remembrance thus seems to be an invaluable desideratum of endeavours in religious education
